

COOKIE POLICY

BillLine (hereinafter "BillLine", "we", "our" or "us") uses cookie technologies to offer you personalized content on the website. In this section we describe the detailed purposes for which we use cookies.

What are cookies and why do we use them?

A cookie is a small text file downloaded to a device or read by a browser (such as a personal computer, laptop or smartphone) when a user accesses certain websites.

Almost every site uses cookie technology to optimize the design and functionality of the website. Cookies also make your interaction with websites safer and faster, because they can remember your personal settings (login or language) and send information back to the website containing the cookie or to another website to which it belongs (third party cookies) when visiting the website again from the same device.

Depending on the purposes for which cookies are used, they are usually divided into the following categories used by BillLine:

Essential cookies enable you to use the website and its main features. They are usually set in response to your actions, such as logging into your personal account on the website. These cookies are necessary in order to use our website.

Functional cookies are used to remember you when you visit the website again and to provide an improved personalized service. For example, a website may greet you in person or remember information about your choice of language or location. These cookies collect information anonymously and cannot track visits to other websites.

Analytical and performance cookies allow us to collect information about how you use the website and how many times you visit it. For example, we collect information about which pages you visit most often and receive error messages. This allows us to improve our website, including providing quick access to important or relevant information for you. These cookies serve only to improve the quality of the website.

Targeting or advertising cookies are designed to remember the number of visits to our website, as well as the list of pages you open and the links you follow. These cookies are designed to ensure you receive only relevant advertising information that matches your preferences. They serve only to limit the number of impressions of advertising messages, and also help us to measure the effectiveness of our advertising campaigns. We may also share this information with third parties (such as advertisers) for the same purposes.

Use of Third Party Cookies

BillLine uses third parties to learn about your using of this website to optimize your user experience, and to serve ads outside of this website. Such third parties (including, for example, ad networks or providers of external services such as web traffic analytics services) may also use cookies outside of our control.

How to refuse the use of cookies?

You can refuse to store cookies on your device at any time. To do this, follow the instructions below.

Changing your web browser settings.

If you want to delete the cookies collected on your device and set your web browser to refuse cookies, you can do this in your web browser settings. Generally, cookie-related navigation options can be found in the "Options", "Tools" or "Favorites" sections of the web browser used to access this website.
